

River of Grass Canoe Expedition **Volunteer Opportunities**

The following opportunities are available to volunteers who wish to participate in the expedition or flotilla. Please indicate your area of interest and availability. Our expedition leader and logistics volunteer will contact you to work out final details.

- Transportation:** It would be useful to have access to the following vehicles and drivers to transport gear and people: one or two pick-ups for gear, a 15-person passenger van, or two 9 passenger vehicles, two boat-trailers and two hitches, January 2

- Set-up:** Assist paddlers with set up, January 2

- Portage Assistance:** Support the paddlers at various locations (times and locations will be provided)

- Meals on Wheels:** Individual or group interested in preparing designated breakfast or dinner meals for a group of 14 people. (Times and locations would need to be organized well-in-advance.)

- Fast Boats:** Individual who would have immediate access to power boats, and be willing to be on call for quick response if necessary. Lake Okeechobee (Okee-Tantie, Okeechobee/Taylor Cr., Nubbins Cr., Chancy Bay, Port Mayaca), L8 access, M Canal access, and Grassy Waters.

- Medical On Call Support:** Indicate when available between January 2-7

- Final Clean-Up Preparation:** Pull together, set-up and return necessary clean up gear (wash bins, tables, hoses, scrubbers, etc.)

- Final Clean-Up:** Join core paddlers for a cleaning party – Be ready to get wet!
